**WHEREAS**, the City of Wewahitchka, Gulf County, Florida, on the **9th** day of **September 2025**, held the first public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and

**WHEREAS** the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Gulf County, Florida, has been certified by the Gulf County Property Appraiser to the City of Wewahitchka as \$104,441,616.00

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City of Wewahitchka, Gulf County, Florida, that:

- 1. The Fiscal Year **2025** / **2026** operating millage rate for Citywide is <u>6.1133 mills</u>, which is <u>more than</u> the rolled-back rate of <u>5.6768 mills</u> by <u>7.69%</u>
- 2. The Fiscal Year **2025** / **2026** operating millage rate of **6.1133 mills** as shown above is adopted by vote of the City Commission as evidenced by the signatures hereon following the first public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065.
