WHEREAS, the City of Wewahitchka, Gulf County, Florida, on the **9th** day of **September 2025**, held the first public hearing and adopted a tentative millage rate as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wewahitchka, Gulf County, Florida, held a FINAL public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and

WHEREAS the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Gulf County, Florida, has been certified by the Gulf County Property Appraiser to the City of Wewahitchka as \$104,441,616.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Wewahitchka, Gulf County, Florida, that:

- 1. The Fiscal Year **2025** / **2026** operating millage rate for Citywide is **6.1133 mills**, which is **more than** the rolled-back rate of **5.6768 mills** by **7.69%**
- 2. The Fiscal Year **2025** / **2026** operating millage rate of **6.1133 mills** as shown above is adopted by vote of the City Commission as evidenced by the signatures hereon following the FINAL public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065.
- 3. This ORDINANCE shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
