



The City of Wewahitchka is proposing the following projects for application to be submitted for the **Rebuild Florida Mitigation General Infrastructure Program (CDBG-MIT Funds)**:

- Construct a new building located at the northern portion of 324 North Highway 71 to act as a storm shelter and information hub for the next catastrophic storm event. The proposed 60' x 120' structure will be equipped with full kitchen amenities to serve the community meals as well. The City is proposing a 2.75-million-dollar budget for the completion of this proposed project.
